Besides a 'live' demonstration, there will also be a display of kasut manek (beaded slippers/shoes), velvet ceremonial wedding collars and other traditional Peranakan pieces.

Be enthralled by the sweet sounds of Suara Sayang comprising 17 singers and musicians who play the ukulele and Chinese lute. With the hope of spreading the Peranakan heritage, the group will serenade the crowd with adaptations of songs like *Bunga Sayang*, *Gunong Payong* and more.

In celebration of our nation's birthday, Gunong Sayang Association (GSA) and its members will fill the Flower Dome with music, song and dance, featuring the GSA Singers, Dendang Irama band and Suara Sayang.
