

- Leaf Collage Activity -

Otter

Otters are sometimes spotted at Gardens by the Bay! These brown, furry creatures usually feed on fish and can be seen hunting in the lakes and ponds at the Gardens.

Look for a fallen, long, narrow leaf to complete the otter's tail! Use double-sided tape or glue to stick on the leaf.

- One long, narrow leaf
- Double-sided tape or glue (we recommend the former!)






- Leaf Collage Activity -**Dragonfly**

Dragonflies of various colours can be spotted zipping around Gardens by the Bay! These flying insects have four wings and hold their wings open while at rest.

Look for fallen, long, narrow leaves to complete the dragonfly's wings! Use double-sided tape or glue to stick on two leaves on each side of its body.

- Four, long, narrow leaves of roughly the same size
- Double-sided tape or glue (we recommend the former!)






- Leaf Collage Activity -Butterfly

Butterflies of different colours and sizes can be spotted fluttering around Gardens by the Bay! These flying insects have large, brightly-coloured wings with interesting patterns.

Look for fallen leaves of different shapes and hues to add colour to the butterfly! Cut the leaves into smaller pieces to fill its body and wings and use double-sided tape or glue to stick them on.

- Leaves of different colours
- Scissors
- Double-sided tape or glue (we recommend the former!)





- Leaf Collage Activity -**Supertree**

There are 18 Supertrees at Gardens by the Bay! They vary in height and are beautifully lit up at night.

Look for fallen leaves of different shapes and hues to add colour to the Supertree! Cut the leaves into smaller pieces to fill its trunk and use double-sided tape or glue to stick them on.

- Leaves of different colours
- Scissors
- Double-sided tape or glue (we recommend the former!)
