One day, someone new appears.








He likes the fresh air and clean surroundings.

The young dragonfly has never seen one before.






ext, the dragonflies spot a green paddy frog snoring in the shade.

They provide food and protection to the fishes.






She is getting ready to dive into the water to catch some fish for breakfast.

This helps her to dive quickly in and out of the water.




ee Dee tries to grab "a piece of paper" floating in the breeze.
