







# Flower Dome

Spectacular and innovative, it is the largest glass greenhouse in the world as listed in the 2015 Guinness World Records!

Central Chile.




Succulent Garden

Crassulas.

















Explore the highlands amidst orchids, pitcher plants and ferns from the cool-moist Tropical Montane region.











Visit the discovery zones for an interactive educational adventure.




#### Cloud Walk

Explore a collection of intriguing stalactites and stalagmites, and see real specimens of rock crystal formation.




## **Cloud Forest Theatre**








#### Dance

Be greeted by a lush, colourful tableau of flowering plants suspended from the ceiling, which move sinuously in mesmerising fashion at Dance, the first of the four garden landscapes of Floral Fantasy.



#### Waltz

Take a stroll down Waltz amidst the rain oasis and waterfalls of flowers among the cascading rocks and winding driftwood. Imagine walking through a forest in the rain as you explore the third garden landscape.

Discover the living gems of the rainforest and ponder the fragility of our biodiversity - Poison Dart Frogs. Despite being tiny - only about 1.5cm in length, the size of an adult thumbnail - they are hard to miss because of their brilliant colouring.



#### Float

Continues into the next garden landscape, Float where bubbling brook streams through the grassy knolls.



## Drift

Enter the last garden landscape, a cave-like space that is ringed with terraced rock formations. The semi-enclosed space is set aglow with soft lighting, creating an enthralling atmosphere.


