Indonesian orchid highlights of Orchid Extravaganza: Rhythm of the Rainforest



Antelope orchids (*Dendrobium* sect. *Spatulata* hybrids)

Named for their twisted, antler-like petals that resemble an antelope's horns, they are prized for their unusual form and long-lasting flowers.



Ground orchids (*Spathoglottis plicata*)

Among the first plants to naturally recolonise Krakatau following its 1883 eruption, it is distinguished by its vibrant magenta blooms.



Moon orchids (*Phalaenopsis amabilis*)

One of Indonesia's three national flowers, it is renowned for its elegant sprays of broad white blooms with soft yellow centres.



Tiger orchid (*Grammatophyllum speciosum*)

The world's largest orchid species, it produces flower spikes that can exceed 2m in height and bear hundreds of tawny yellow blooms richly marked with maroon blotches.

Among the award-winning entries at this year's Singapore Orchid Show are 48 orchids cultivated by Gardens by the Bay. Grown and nurtured by the Gardens' horticulturists, these prize-winning specimens highlight the expertise and dedication behind our orchid collection.

Gardens by the Bay also emerged as one of the top winners at the show, clinching two of the competition's four highest honours — Best Species Plant and Best Specimen Plant.
