TULIP VARIETIES OF NOTE

TULIP VARIETIES CULTIVATED FROM NATIVE SPECIES OF TÜRKIYE			
	Tulipa acuminata A tulip variety that is cultivated from native species with origins in Turkiye, the <i>Tulipa acuminata</i> has long, pointed petals that are a mixture of red and yellow, normally with more yellow towards the base and red towards the tips. It looks markedly different from the conventional cup-shape that most people associate with tulips.		
	<i>Tulipa</i> 'Fly Away' <i>Tulipa</i> 'Fly Away' features goblet-shaped blooms with pointed petals in a vivid red, delicately edged with yellow edges.		



<i>Tulipa '</i> Go Go Red'
<i>Tulipa</i> 'Go Go Red' boasts slim, pointed petals in a vivid red that flare outward from a bright yellow centre, creating a striking, star-like shape.

Tulipa White Liberstar'

Tulipa 'White Liberstar' is a crown tulip with white petals that gracefully curve outward, characterised by distinctive crown-shaped blooms that were originally the result of a genetic mutation.

Tulipa 'Ballerina'

Tulipa 'Ballerina' is an elegant variety with bright orange petals that flare outwards at the tips.



<i>Tulipa</i> 'Claudia' <i>Tulipa</i> 'Claudia' has goblet-shaped flowers and pointed petals that are beetroot purple, with a dark purple flush at the base and white edges.
<i>Tulipa</i> 'Pretty Woman' has bright red, goblet-shaped flowers with pointed petals and a faint sweet scent.

OTHER TULIP HIGHLIGHTS			
	<i>Tulipa</i> 'Red Princess' features deep crimson petals that are peony-like in shape, with subtle hints of green and yellow near the base. It also carries a slight fragrance.		



<i>Tulipa</i> 'Spryng Break'	
<i>Tulipa</i> 'Spryng Break' is a triumph tulip that begins blooming in a creamy white with reddish pink flame-like stripes, that become more variegated as the flower ages.
