Flower Dome tickets for 500 Singapore residents with disrupted Japan travel plans

What: Singapore residents whose trip to Japan during cherry blossom season between March 1 and May 31 was disrupted by COVID-19, get the chance to visit Flower Dome for free during the Sakura Matsuri floral display.

They will need to share what their disrupted Japan trip meant to them, and provide proof of trip cancellation by way of an email notification from the airline or travel agency. The flight or trip confirmation from a travel agency with the names of all travellers going on the same trip is also required.
